ORDINANCE NO 222

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PERMIT REQUIREMENT AND OTHER REGULATIONS OF GARAGE OR RUMMAGE SALES AND AUCTIONS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SUMRALL, MISSISSIPPI

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SUMRALL, MISSISSIPPI

SECTION 1: UNLAWFUL WITHOUT PERMIT

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, transient, merchant, hawker, or peddler to vend, sell, dispose, offer or, auction to vend, sale, dispose or display any goods, wares, or merchandise on any public walk, street, alley, or anywhere within the town, without having first obtained a permit from the City Clerk for that purpose and having paid a permit fee therefor, as hereinafter provided. This ordinance does not apply to produce peddlers

SECTION 2: GARAGE, CARPORT, YARD, RUMMAGE SALES AND AUCTIONS

A garage, carport, yard, rummage sale, and auction shall mean display of, sale or offering to sale any type of goods, wares, merchandise, food or drink at any location within the Town of Sumrall, and said terms shall be accorded their common meaning, but shall not include any other business activity for which a privilege license is required by law.

SECTION 3: APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

Application for permit to vend, sell, dispose, display, or auction merchandise, goods or wares shall be made in writing to the City Clerk.

The application shall contain:

The name of the applicant, if an individual; the names of partners, if a partnership; or the name of principal officers, if a corporation.

The date of the application

The date of the sale

The address of the place of residence

The address of the location of the sale

Persons other than applicant who will be associated with the sale including but not limited to employees and persons in interest.

The permit fee to be charged for such application is five dollars(\$5.00) for all permits except for an auction. A permit for an auction is twenty-five dollars(\$25.00). Such permit when issued shall authorize sale for a period not to exceed one (1) day. No permit shall be issued more than 14 days prior to sale.

SECTION 4: LIMITED SALES

No permit for a garage, carport, yard, rummage sale, or auction shall be issued for any one location for more than two (2) sales during any twelve (12) month period. In addition no permit for a garage, carport, yard, rummage sale, or auction shall be issued to any one family or organization, regardless of location for more than two(2) sales during any twelve (12) month period. Organizations shall be defined as a corporation, partnership, or association, two or more persons having a joint or common interest, or any other legal or commercial entity. Family shall be defined as those persons who are of the same lineage, or have descended from one common progenitor and shall also include spouses, in-laws, and step relatives of such person.

SECTION 5: LOCATION RULES

No street or alley shall be blocked by any merchandise offered for sale hereunder. A two (2) foot passage way for pedestrians shall be left open, and merchandise shall be securely and adequately placed so that it will not endanger persons passing by or fall or extrude into any street or alley. Such sales shall not be operated in any manner which would cause a nuisance, or create a fire hazard.

SECTION 6: POST PERMIT IN CONSPICUOUS PLACE

Each permit shall be kept posted in a conspicuous place at the site of the garage, carport, yard, rummage sale or auction. Failure of the person to so exhibit the permit shall be prima facie evidence that the permit has not been procured.

SECTION 7: REMOVAL OF MERCHANDISE

All items displayed or offered for sale must be removed from public view within thirty(30) minutes after sundown; this includes all boxes, display racks, tables, and other storage units.

SECTION 8: INSPECTIONS AT SITE

The Chief of Police shall make or cause to be made to be made sufficient inspections to insure the compliance with the provisions of this ordinance by the personnel conduction such sales.

SECTION 9: PENALTIES

Any persons, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be not less than ten dollars(\$10.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.
